Our most captivating Cabernet Franc release yet! The 2024 Morgensen Family Vineyard Cabernet Franc explores four unique aging methods. That's right—same wine, aged in four different vessels, each bringing out distinct characteristics. This is not just a Livermore Valley accomplishment, but a truly one-of-a-kind wine on the global stage.

- Steel:** Aged 12 months in Stainless Steel
- Rock:** Aged 12 months in Concrete
- Wood:** Aged 12 months in Neutral Barrel
- Elements:** Aged 12 months in Steel, Concrete, & Wood.

The Elements Series of Cab Franc is an exploration into how much the structure of wine is dependent upon the vessel it is aged in. From the comparative inertness of **Steel** to the chalky tannins of **Rock** to the gently rounding effect of neutral oak in **Wood**, these wines help to open Cab Franc up to greater understanding and to much greater enjoyment.

Nearly a decade before Abraham Lincoln was president, the Mirassou Family, America's oldest family of winemakers, was getting its hands dirty in some of the most beautiful vineyard soil in the world. 7 generations later we've learned that our home, the Livermore Valley, is one of the greatest places in the world to grow the world's greatest grape: Cab Franc.

Situated on hillsides 1000 feet above sea level and prone to daily wind from San Francisco Bay, the growing conditions in the Livermore Valley are ideal for world-class Cab Franc.

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Often harvesting fruit in mid-November, we are able to produce gorgeous wines at low alcohol levels, wines that sing of long harvests, energetic acidity, elegance, and sheer deliciousness.

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The first great appellation in California, the historic Livermore Valley is undergoing a renaissance with an appellation-wide focus on Cab Franc and Sauvignon Blanc as its [signature varieties](#).

The Steven Kent Winery is focused on producing Cab Franc that showcases the variety's innate balance and complexity. By eschewing new oak and, instead, aging in concrete, stainless steel and neutral puncheons, our wines reflect the places they were grown and a winemaking philosophy that seeks pure flavors and aromatics.

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Exciting, fresh, beautiful, and delicious, Cab Franc is the perfect wine to do wine's primary job: strengthen the emotional connections that make the everyday full of joy and magic.

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Each vintage, we make more than a dozen different wines from Cab Franc, including a [Livermore Valley red blend from multiple vineyards](#) and a [Cab Franc Blanc](#), a unique wine, showcasing unadulterated fruit and great acidity.
